All actions are driven by sincerity to fulfil God's rights and the rights of mankind when responding to poverty and suffering.



A summary of our projects that we committed to this financial year.

01 Water Projects

Over 170 wells, pumps, filter plants, tankers, water coolers installed for communities that are grateful.

02Warmth Projects

Hundreds supported through the severest winters with blankets, clothing and food.

03 Orphan Sponsorships

Over 50 hifz and orphan sponsorships. These children are now aspiring.

04 Masjid Projects

Two Masjid's constructed in places of great need allowing communities to spiritually connect.

05Healthcare Projects

Over 5,000 have benefited from free healthcare including wheelchair distribution and medical aid.

06 Housing Projects

Nine very special families have had complete houses constructed allowing them to have a shelter over their heads

We have raised just over £250,000 through emergency appeals, sponsored events and campaigns.


Income & Expenditure Summary

Hassan Attar, Living an Impoverished Life in Zanzibar

This is Hassan Attar, he is from Unguja, Zanzibar. He is 3 years old. He comes from a destitute family who simply cannot make a living as they don't own any land to agriculture from, so they fish which is extremely competitive and with no boats or equipment they only catch enough to feed themselves.

Our UK team were sent on a deployment in April 2022 to provide families like Hassan's with nutritious food. Our longer term objective is to provide animals to such families so that they can start to become financially stable.

Hassan's parents said "we are forever grateful for As-Salaam's team to come all the way from the UK to support our basic needs. We like any parents just want good for our children".

You too can help a family like Hassan's by providing monthly food packs for £45, a well built house for £5,000 or cash assistance of your choice.



Kawere Abdul Maliki, An Orphan from Uganda

This is Kawere Abdul Maliki from Makenya, Uganda. He is 6 years old. He was orphaned in Feb 2022 as his father was involved in a motor accident. His sole guardians is his grandmother Baluka Jamilah, who is widowed and has no source of income. He suffered from scabies and had hope to become a doctor one day.

As-Salaam Foundation had a concern for Kaware's future and we managed to match a perfect donor to him to help take care, educate and create a chance for him to aspire in life. Now, Kawere is healthy, happy and is a step closer in life to achieving his dreams!

Kawere said "I am happy I am learning and not working. I would love to help people when I am a doctor".

Water Projects

785 million people live without access to clean water which adversely affects each country's economy with the rapid increase of waterborne diseases and other fatal diseases including typhoid, diarrhoea, intestinal worms and hepatitis. We have worked tirelessly to provide clean water to Uganda, Pakistan, Syria and Yemen. We do this with the installation of hand pumps, wells and reverse osmosis systems to counteract diseases. It is also with great honour we would like to inform donors that our brand-new initiative of solar powered wells is active in Pakistan. We hope to develop this is other countries in the near future.













Food Projects

689 million people live in extreme poverty, surviving on less than £1.40 a day with children and youth accounting for two-thirds of the world's poor, and women represent a majority in most regions. We have made huge strides in overcoming global poverty by providing ongoing nutritional food packs to thousands across Bangladesh, Uganda, Pakistan, Yemen, Tanzania, Syria, Palestine, Sudan and Gambia. Moreover, we have committed to have our own hot meals kitchen in Yemen, Palestine and Syria where you can sponsor a hot meal for just £1.













Construction Projects

This year we worked on purpose-built residential villages dedicated to the families of the war for the people of Syria and Yemen. Eeach apartment is approx, forty meters and consists of two rooms, a kitchen and a bathroom. Future plans are to build a Quran institute for children and women, recreational grounds so families can regain some form of normality in their daily lives. Each apartment costs £1800 to build and an additional £500 to fully furnish with the basic household goods. We also constructed houses in Tanzania for £6,000 each on a remote island known as Tumbatu. Moreover, two beautiful medium sized Masjids were constructed in Uganda.













Orphan and Hifz Sponsorships

Orphan children are vulnerable to several development challenges impacting their safeguarding including quality of education, sexual exploitation, child trafficking, marriage, and labour. We have supported over 50 orphans and Hifz students across the world in Uganda, Syria, Pakistan and Sudan, providing them with basic necessities including food, clothing, education and shelter. We also provide psychological support to these vulnerable children. It is amazing that just $\pounds 1$ a day can make such a huge difference.













2022/23 Targets

Sustainability

We aim to achieve this by:

HELPING CHILDREN TO BE STUDENTS OF SUSTAINABILITY.



Working with educational NGOs, we aim to help the next generation explore the latest thinking in sustainable living. Our joint programs will reach and teach thousands of students across 15 countries. Working with schools to make sustainability part of our collective future, it's a partnership that promotes prosperity and secures our future.

MORE ENERGY EFFICIENT PROJECTS - SOLAR POWERED SYSTEMS.

We understand that during the process of installing fuel based generators to operate wells, can waste millions of tonnes of waste emissions that gets emitted into the atmosphere. Therefore, to reduce these emissions we aim to work more with energy efficient systems i.e. solar powered systems. We have already started a fantastic partnership with an NGO in Pakistan to install solar powered wells where electricity and generators are not needed, saving the environment. Moreover, increasing the scope of where they can be installed and getting to remote locations ultimately benefiting more of our beneficiaries.

ASSISTING IMPOVERISED FAMILIES TO BECOME FINANCIALLY INDEPENDENT.

We are looking at methods of providing families with a more permanent solution for their financial requirements. We will be investing more into schemes such as interest free business loans, providing agricultural land for families to benefit from, supplying farm animals where the needy can benefit from and so on. This in turn will allow them to become more financially stable, longer term.

RECYCLING.

By the end of the year we aim to have a recycling programme for second-hand clothing, houseware, and knickknacks. Any money raised will be used back into our projects. This will reduce the amount of waste sent to landfills and incinerators, conserves natural resources such as timber, water and minerals, prevents pollution by reducing the need to collect new raw materials and saves energy.

HAVING A SUSTAINABILITY AND ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Codifying the commitment to sustainability will help us to vocalise what we value and what we are working towards. Hopefully having recurring sustainability and environment events and challenges for our volunteers as well. This will be available on our website with our other various policies.
