With a deep sense of responsibility, we have committed ourselves to ensuring that the foundation continues to make a significant and positive impact in the lives of those we aim to assist.





REBUILDING **PAKISTAN**

SYRIA EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

The people of Syria, already grappling with ongoing conflicts and poverty, faced yet another calamity when a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck on 6 February, followed by aftershocks and subsequent quakes. This series of seismic events has had a devastating impact, causing further loss of life and adding to the already dire living conditions. The confirmed death toll in Syria alone stands at 8,476, with countless others injured or left homeless.



On Eid, amidst the pain and adversity that so many have endured, our charity was able to offer a glimmer of joy and a sense of normality to children and families through special celebrations.

The air was filled with laughter and smiles as children received Eid gifts, played with toys, and delighted in the colourful balloons. Through the distribution of gifts you have donated, face painting, and dressed-up characters, these children were able to enjoy a special day.



Yusif Ali, a wonderful 12 year old boy was suffering from malnutrition when As-Salaam Foundation came to his aid. Since As-Salaam Foundation started supporting him and his family with food he's gained weight and looks healthier and happier.

The famine in Yemen is one of the worst food crises in modern history, leaving millions malnourished and in immediate need of aid. The scarcity of food has led to skyrocketing prices, making basic sustenance unaffordable for the vast majority.











The cold weather adds another layer of hardship for those already living on the edge. Many lack adequate housing, living in makeshift shelters that offer little to no protection from the elements.

WORK IN UGANDA

Our charity is committed to addressing urgent issues in Uganda, where around 83% of the population lacks access to clean water and over 110,000 children have died from malnutrition between 2004-2009.

We focus on orphan sponsorship for vulnerable children, water projects to provide small wells for clean water access, and masjid projects to build more durable worship spaces, often replacing structures made merely of bamboo and leaves.

These initiatives not only address immediate needs but also aim for sustainable impact.









The Israeli-Palestinian conflict is one of the world's most enduring conflicts. The conflict's casualties have not been restricted to combatants, with a large number of civilian fatalities on both sides.

Members of the Euro-Med Monitor team have documented in this report the killing of 204 Palestinians by Israeli army forces in 2022.

With this sharp increase in violence, more and more humanitarian efforts are being made to support those who are being adversely affected. Basic necessities including food/water, clothing. Housing and medical assistance is always required.

The unemployment rate in Bangladesh decreased to 4.7% in 2022 from 5.1 percent in the previous year, pointing to the lowest jobless rate since 2019.

The duration of unemployment is often long. Almost half (47%) of unemployed youth look for work for longer than one year.

This project will serve as a catalyst in increasing daily earnings, reducing the poverty level of the beneficiaries, and facilitating them to maintain their daily livelihood within this income.

Livelihood Restoration: Implement livelihood support programs to help affected communities rebuild their means of earning a living, such as through agriculture or vocational training.

Seed and Livestock Distribution: Provide farmers with seeds, tools, and livestock to restart agricultural activities and regain food security.

Education on Food Security: Educate communities about food security practices, sustainable agriculture, and the importance of diversifying food sources.

Access to Education: Increase access to education for marginalised and underserved populations, including children with disabilities and those living in remote areas.

We have been been been additional back into the foundation from our Gift Aid account so that our beneficiaries can benefit further.

Effective cost control is a pivotal aspect of successful management of our foundation. This involves the strategic management and optimisation of expenses to ensure that financial resources are utilised efficiently while maintaining the quality and functionality of aid that we provide to our beneficiaries.



As trustees we have been able to establish welldefined budgets for different projects and allocate resources appropriately.



We have been able to continuously track expenses against budgeted amounts allowing for early detection of discrepancies and deviations, enabling timely corrective actions.







FUNDRAISING

Spous manuals come together to compete in tournaments such as golf, tennis, or football, with registration fees or sponsorship benefiting a cause.

On two occasions we held an all UK university football tournament and raised over £2,300.

Volunteer Drives

These events encourage community members to volunteer their time and skills for a specific cause. Activities might include cleaning up a park, building homes, or assisting in a food drive. On several occasions, our volunteers committed their time towards a homeless drive, providing them with a warm meal and accessories to keep them warm during cold periods. They raised over £300.



Charity Car Washes

A charity car wash is a fundraising event in which volunteers wash cars for a fee, and the proceeds collected are donated to a charitable cause.

This year our volunteers have raised over £4,100 from three charity car washes.

A Day Of Giving

Local businesses get involved to raise money through selling products and/or offering their services.

We teamed up with a local dessert business who sold their cakes and drinks and handed over 50% of their profits to us to use on an agreed cause. We have had two giving days this year, raising over £9,800.
